- Is pursuing a baccalaureate degree, majoring in one or more of the following areas: Mass Communications, Electronic Media, Radio, Video, TV, or Print Media, preferably but not limited to an emphasis in radio broadcasting.
- Has attained a good scholastic record.
- Has demonstrated good citizenship and respect for society

**Required Materials:**

- Completed application form. (Only complete applications will be considered.)
- Most current college transcript
- One 500-word essay describing your passion for Mass Communications and how you intend to apply this degree.
- Three confidential letters of recommendations including one from a professor within your field of study, one from your advisor or other college employee or professor and one from a peer.
